Inquiry-based instruction shifts the power dynamics of classrooms, by giving students (as well as underrepresented communities and perspectives) more voice, independence, and authority.

Develop your capacity as an instructional leader to support instruction that is student-centered - instruction that develops student abilities to appreciate the perspective of others, analyze and address social injustice, and address classroom, school, and community concerns.

In this workshop, you will:

- develop tools to help teachers engage in inquiry to deepen student learning
- facilitate and support the teacher dispositional shift that will allow for more student choice and voice
- practice strategies to effectively collaborate with teachers to build a vision for equity-focused inquiry-based instruction across the disciplines.
